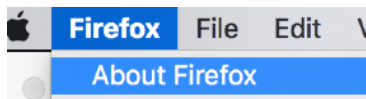


Updating Firefox

1. Check your Firefox version. To do this:

- Open **Firefox**
- In the top left of the **Firefox menu**, click on **Firefox > About Firefox**.



- **If you have the option to update from the window**, go ahead and do so by clicking the **Restart Firefox to Update** button.



- **If you do have the option to update from the window**, the version you have may be too old. Use **steps 2-7** below to update Firefox. (Ignore the steps below if you were able to update Firefox using the window in the step above.)

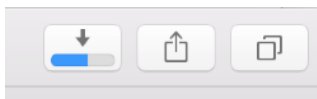
2. Quit **Firefox**

3. Open **Safari**, go to: <https://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/new/>

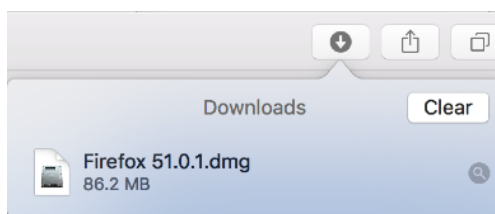
4. Click the green **Free Download** button.



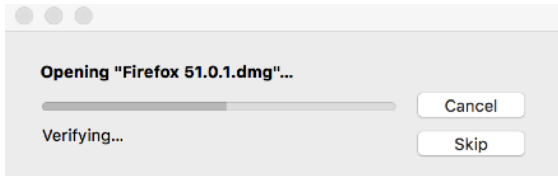
5. Firefox will begin downloading. You can see the progress on the **Show Downloads** button in the top right of your Safari screen.





6. When it finishes downloading, click on the **Show Downloads** button. Then double-click on the **Firefox 51.0.1.dmg**.



7. The download will begin opening.



8. Inside the blue **Firefox window**, click, hold and drag the **Firefox icon**  to the Applications folder  and drop it.



9. Click **Replace**.

10. Double-click on the **Firefox icon** in your dock to open it.

11. Click **Open**.

12. To keep your Firefox up to date, regularly check for updates. To do this:

- Open **Firefox**
- In the top left of the **Firefox menu**, click on **Firefox > About Firefox**.
- Click the **Restart Firefox to Update** button.
